How BT Managed Streaming works

Streaming, or webcasting, enables you to deliver high impact, rich-media messages including video, audio and presentations to your audience over the internet.

Streaming integrates seamlessly with all of the conferencing services offered by BT so you can enjoy all of the benefits of true unified collaboration.

What you need to do

Decide on the message you wish to deliver and we will take care of everything else. We will stream the live event and also make a recording available for later viewing.

How to view a BT Managed streamed event

You need:

A personal computer or laptop with:

- Internet access
- Sound card
- Speakers
- Adobe® Flash® Player.

or an Android or iOS mobile device.

View a live streamed event

You will be given a URL as part of your booking confirmation. As soon as you have the URL and if you're running your own event, you can upload slides and start practising before the event starts. Simply email this URL to the audience wanting to watch your streamed event, who will click on the URL and enter their registration details if requested to do so.

View an on demand streamed event

You will be given a URL as part of your booking confirmation. After your event has finished email this to those people wanting to watch your streamed event. They click on the URL to watch. On demand content is typically available within 1.5 times the event duration. For example, if you have a two hour live event your on demand stream will be available approximately three hours after your event finishes.

Confirming your event

After booking, you will receive a confirmation email. This will confirm all of your event information e.g. date and time of the streamed event and the URL for your audience to use to watch the streamed event.

Manage the audience

An optional registration page enables you to collect valuable information from your audience before they access the content of the streamed event. With the optional Presentation package you can produce and present your streaming session with a variety of tools. These include question and answer sessions and voting by your audience to gauge understanding. You can also create an index of your archived presentation for fast and easy navigation.

Manage the event

BT Conferencing understands that event requirements vary per customer so we offer different levels of integrated services that can incorporate audio, web, video, streaming and on site Event Management. This enables you to reach your target audience and ensure that location isn't a barrier to conducting efficient, cost-effective and wide-reaching meetings.

For more complex, important events, BT provides an optional comprehensive Event Management service including:

- Pre-call consultation and access test
- Preparation and organisation
- Running the conference
- Custom productions
- Post event debrief.

This service can also include co-ordinating AV equipment, as well as on-site management.

- Video signal: typically we'll use video conference, but we can optionally use satellite, fibre optic or on-site encoding
- Audio signal: we can utilise PSTN or video conference.

Call charges apply for capturing the signal.

BT Managed Streaming packages

Standard streaming packages include the following:

- Minimum event duration: 1 hour, which can be optionally extended
- 90 day replay to allow those who missed your event to access it at a time that's convenient to them
- Welcome screen to hold your audience until your event starts
- Advanced reporting and analytics to measure engagement and effectiveness
- Event delivery to mobile devices to maximise the reach of your message
- Confirmation, reminder and post-event user emails to maximise the success of the event.

Optional features to engage your audience

- Enhance your event with a wide choice of widgets including Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, Idea, Group Chat and Wikipedia
- The event can be set up to allow your audience to choose how they wish to view the event e.g. to move the slides and video to a size and position of their choice
- Presenter screen share capability allows effective application demonstrations
- Audience surveys
- Presentation package to enhance your event by giving you the ability to show PowerPoint slides as part of your stream or for presenters to control visual information during your event.
